



The Northwest Football Awards is organised by Road3 Ltd and the Northwest Football Awards partners. It is free to enter all Awards categories.

#### **Terms and Conditions of entry – Northwest Football Awards 2022**

1. All entries must be based on activity that took place last season (07 August 2021 – 29 May 2022)
2. Each nomination must be entered separately using a different entry form in each case
3. All entries must be received by Road3/NWFA by 5pm on the Friday, 19 August 2022.
4. Entries are open to any professional football league club in the Northwest of England and companies or individuals, working in football and/or the business of Northwest football clubs, provided the football clubs that they work with are based in Northwest of England
5. On receipt of your entry, the awards administrators will confirm its arrival via email. If you do not obtain such a receipt within three days, it is your responsibility to contact us to confirm its arrival. Unless you have this written or verbal confirmation from us, we cannot guarantee the arrival of your entry
6. Entry forms will be accepted through the Northwest Football Awards website, with any supporting evidence provided in hard copy as necessary
7. Projects entered into more than one category must be treated as separate entries
8. All entries must be supplied and conform to category rules/submission formats
9. The judges reserve the right to reallocate nominations, which in their view have been entered in the wrong category
10. The organisers reserve the right to publish/exhibit screen grabs, video footage and/or submitted reports in relation to the awards
11. The organisers reserve the right to verify that all entries have been commercially produced for a commercial client/club where relevant
12. Entries and supporting evidence cannot be returned
13. All entries submitted must be legal. Any entries containing offensive material will be disqualified
14. The judges' decision is final and there will be no appeals
15. We cannot offer detailed feedback about specific shortlisting decisions or any details about individual entries
16. All award finalists will be asked to take part in promotional activity and by submitting your entry, you give your permission to Northwest Football Awards and its partners to use the details of your entry to promote the Northwest Football Awards. This could include but is not limited to websites, press releases and print
17. By submitting an entry to the awards, you are committing to attending the event in person on the night should you be shortlisted as a finalist.
